

Juniper Ridge Trail #640



Distance: 12.44 miles
Short Loop - 6.11 miles
Long Loop – 11.40 miles

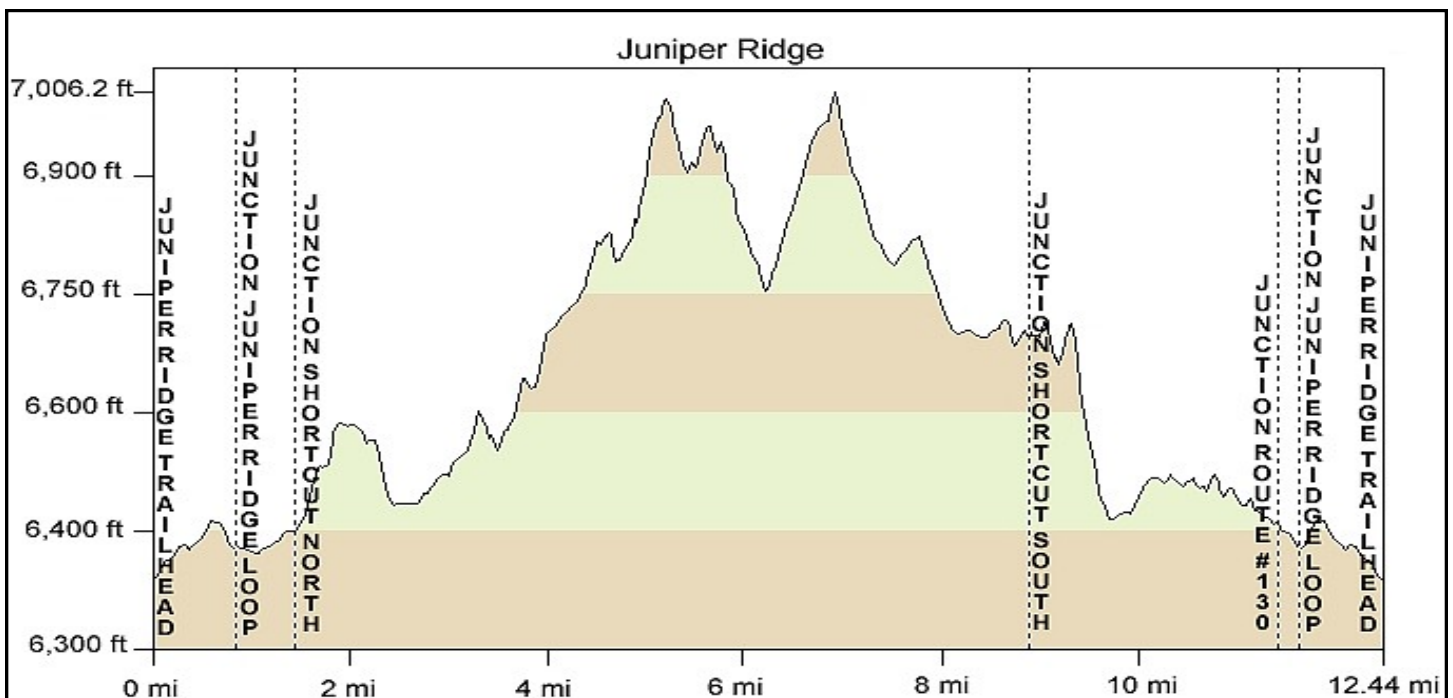
Hiking - Moderate
Mountain Biking - Difficult
Equestrian - Moderate

Trailhead Parking: Limited, accommodates trailers

Access to Trail: From the Show Low Post Office, travel west on AZ 260 for 11 miles to Farnsworth Ranch Road. Turn left and the trailhead is 2 miles ahead on the Left.

Trail Highlights: The short loop takes you on a six and one half mile hike through some of the area burned out by the Rodeo-Chediski Fire of 2002. The main loop goes for a distance of 12.4 miles and is now signed with blue diamonds. This trail goes past the Lookout Tower and more of the burned area. Watch out for trees blown down on both trails. Both trails also give interesting views of ecological changes caused by the fire.

Note: Portions of this trail intermittently follow old logging roads. Watch for the trail diamonds.



This trail has coded white diamonds, approximately ¼ mile apart, which correspond to the codes on the map below. If you need to call 911 for an emergency, tell the 911 operator the code on the nearest white diamond so that emergency responders can more readily locate you.
